1883 September 12	Born in Saint Louis, Missouri; Parents: Joseph Winkelmann and Anna Decker
1907 June 11	Ordained to Priesthood at Kenrick Seminary
1907-1922	Assistant – Saint Peter's Church, Saint Charles, Missouri
1922-1929	Pastor – Sacred Heart, Richfountain, Missouri
1929-1940	Pastor – Saint Francis de Sales, Saint Louis, Missouri
1933 September 13	Elected Titular Bishop of Sita and Auxiliary Bishop of Saint Louis
1933 November 30	Consecrated Bishop
1939 December 17	Appointed Bishop of Wichita, Kansas
1940 March 05	Installed as Bishop of Wichita, Kansas
1946 November 19	Died in Wichita, Kansas
