Archbishop Rozanski and Area Faith Leaders to Hold Press Conference on House Bill 944 Regarding Guns in Church

ST. LOUIS – Most Reverend Mitchell T. Rozanski and various area faith leaders will gather for a press conference Wednesday, April 28, to share their concerns regarding House Bill 944.

WHAT:

Archbishop Mitchell Rozanski will join area religious leaders in holding a press conference regarding Missouri House Bill 944, which would allow gun owners with a concealed carry permit to bring a weapon into church without the permission of their congregation's leader. This proposal would change the current legal recognition of churches and houses of worship as gun-free zones. Archbishop Rozanski and the other attending faith leaders oppose this bill and believe that the legislation, if passed, would broaden the scope of the Second Amendment at the expense of the First Amendment—infringing upon religious liberty.
