

Transparency in Coverage Rule

In 2020, the Federal Government finalized the "Transparency in Coverage" Rule, which requires health insurers and group health plans to provide cost-sharing data to consumers. This regulation covers only the healthcare and prescription drug plans for PMBS members under age 65. The regulations do not cover the PMBS Medicare plan.

Starting July 1, 2022, insurers and plans must make an online price transparency tool available for 500 shoppable items, services and drugs identified in the final rule. Eventually, all covered services and items will be included. Consumers will be able to get real-time estimates of their cost-sharing liability for health care items and services
