

PRAY, SACRIFICE, INVITE

Bulletin notes can be, and often are, the main source to enlist new adorers. Make the request as "Can you help?" list the hour or hours needed with the coordinator's contact information. Continue to publish the note for two-three weeks. If more than one person responds, offer the second person a different hour that may also need assistance or keep them both at the requested hour. The bishops request two or more adorers to an hour, so focus on weak hours.

There may be some who would like to commit to two or more hours a week. This can be a good thing, but consider this, if this person moves, becomes ill or quits, this would mean that two or more adorers are now needed in place of one. It may be better to consider this as a temporary arrangement and continue to seek others for the weak hour. Suggest to those who would like two or more hours to simply stop in for an extra visit (*Visitors are always welcome*) or to sign up as a substitute.

"After the Mass of the Lord's Supper, the faithful should be encouraged to spend a suitable period of time during the night in the church in adoration before the Blessed Sacrament that has been solemnly reserved...From midnight onward, however, the adoration should be made without external solemnity, for the day of the Lord's passion has begun."
