## **REQUEST FORM**

In accordance with canon 903 of the Code of Canon Law and the guidelines of the USCCB, Dioceses require our priests and deacons to have a Letter of Suitability which is sent to the Diocese where ministry will be exercised. Normally a copy of the letter will also be sent to the priest or deacon and the parish or venue being visited.

Please make requests **at least three weeks prior** to the requested date of ministry for this to be processed, or **one month in advance** if the event is outside the United States. Last minute requests, such as for funerals, can and will be taken care of expeditiously.
