The total number of abortions in the U.S. from 1973 to 2018 is 61.8 million. It is estimated that there are 186 abortions per live births, 2,362 per day, 98 plus abortions per hour, and 1 abortion every 37 seconds. Since 1965, about 11 million women have used abortifacient methods of birth control in the United States. Pharmacy experts say about 14 million chemical abortions happen in the United States each year, resulting in 610 million chemical abortions between 1965 and 2009.
