FAITHFULNESS



Psalm 33:4 For the word of the Lord is upright, and all His work is done in faithfulness.

Joshua 24:14 ... now therefore revere the Lord, and serve Him in sincerity and in faithfulness

FAITHFULNESS ... All spiritual fruits are expressions of the Holy Spirit's gifts, meant to be given away according to the example of Jesus.
