

Not securing credit card terminals can cause financial headaches. Here are the steps you can take **now** to prevent and detect fraud.

SECURE THOSE DEVICES!

Credit card equipment should be stored in a location free from unauthorized access when the machine is not in use.





LOOK FOR TAMPERING

Periodically inspect the device for the following:

- Scratches/damage to the device
- Items attached to the device, such as USBs, skimmers, etc.

RECONCILE, RECONCILE, RECONCILE

Review batch detail reports for:

- Unauthorized transactions (including refunds/credits)
- Duplicate transactions
- Errors (incorrect amounts)
